- Unprotected carpenters and construction workers across the DMV are **victims every single day of crimes against their dignity and safety.**
- **Wage Theft, Worker Misclassification, and Labor Trafficking are crimes** that target minority populations and abuse workers by stealing their wages and benefits. Workers often face retaliation if they speak out.
- **Our community is stronger when ALL workers have a voice.** Through union representation and collective bargaining, workers get the dignity they deserve and have earned.
