Career Connections graduates may have already earned up to 16 TESU Credits from pre-apprentice training, a savings of nearly \$7,000 off the cost of a TESU Associate's Degree. A student's credit eligibility is determined according to the submission of appropriate documentation as well as the documented date of successful pre-apprenticeship completion.

Additionally, TESU recognizes the NCATF Apprenticeship Program for 34 credits toward an Associate's Degree, which leaves only 27 credits to finish. *TESU's credit award for Career Connections is retroactive to April 2019.
